



# Comprehensive Guidelines for Srusti Tech Hack

### Overview

**Srusti TechHack: DigiGram Vikashit Bharat** is a competitive, innovation-driven hackathon in which participants develop digital solutions to address real-world challenges in rural governance. Over two days, participants design, prototype, and present solutions under the theme *DigiGram Vikashit Bharat*.

# **Registration Process**

- Timeline: Registration opens December 15, 2024, and closes January 15, 2025.

- Required Information:

  - Email Address
  - Team Name (if applicable)
  - Area of Interest
  - o Agreement to the Terms and Conditions

# **Team Formation**

- Team Size: 3-5 members.
- Composition:
  - Interdisciplinary teams are encouraged.
  - At least one member must be from a technical background.
- Individual Participation: Individuals can register but are encouraged to form/join teams during the kickoff session.





### **Event Format**

The **Pre-event Online Workshop** on January 23, 2025, at 2:30 PM, will provide detailed information about the problem statement and event format.

**Problem Statement**: Develop a Digital Complaint Management System for Rural Panchayats.

Kickoff Date: January 25, 2025, at 9:30 AM.

Hackathon Duration: Two days (January 25-26, 2025).

- Elimination Rounds:
  - Day 1: Start with 100 participants, reducing to 25 after Round 1 eliminations.
  - Day 2: Begin with 25 participants, selecting the top 3 winners by the end of the event.
- Mode: Entirely in-person at Srusti Academy of Management.

# Mentorship and Mid-Evaluation

- Mid-Evaluations:
  - First checkpoint: January 25, 2025, at 8:00 PM.
  - Second checkpoint: January 26, 2025, at 2:00 PM.
- Mentorship:
  - Available during specific slots.
  - Mentors will guide and provide feedback on progress.

### Final Submission

- Deadline: January 26, 2025, at 5:30 PM.
- Deliverables:
  - Project ID
  - A 10-minute presentation demo.

# Judging Criteria

• Innovation (30%): Originality of the solution.





- Feasibility (25%): Practicality of implementation.
- Impact (20%): Relevance and scalability.
- Technical Quality (15%): Coding standards and completeness.
- Presentation (10%): Clarity and delivery.

### Prizes and Rewards

- 1st Place: ₹ 15,000/- cash, certification, and internship opportunities.
- 2nd Place: ₹10,000/- cash and certification.
- 3rd Place: ₹ 5,000/- cash and certification.

## Feedback Collection

- After the hackathon concludes, participants, mentors, and judges will be invited to share their feedback through an online form.
- The feedback will cover areas such as event organization, technical resources, mentorship quality, and overall experience.

**Platform:** The feedback form will be shared via email and accessible on the Batoi Bridge platform. Feedback must be submitted before the results are announced.

- Submissions must be original; plagiarism leads to disqualification.
- Maintain professional behavior and avoid harassment.
